Masterpoint Breakdown

Inside the Newsletter this month is a list of all our clubs with any home club members as at 31st May 2020. Each club has their home club members grouped into various masterpoint ranges, then expressed as a percentage of their total home down by 85, for the 300-1000 numbers are down club members. The groups have been divided into the following masterpoint groups:

> 0-2020-50 50-100 100-300 300-1000 1000 +

Nationally, including the ABF Youth Club there were 33,101 (down 1769 from last year) registered members. They fell into the following groups:

0-20	13,731	41%
20-50	5,241	16%
50-100	4,048	12%
100-300	5,382	16%
300-1000	3,328	10%
1000+	1,371	4%

Hence you can compare this national average, which is changed very little over the last four years, against the breakdown for your club.

In the 0-20 range, of the 13,731 members in that group (down 1,260 from last year), there are 1.587 (1.765 last year) members with 0.00 masterpoints.

For the same group there are now 7 clubs with their total membership (100%) falling into this group. One up on last year. They are again club 2-095 Helane (with 2 members), again 2-275 Warialda (with 10 members), again 2-279 Watermark (with 5 members), again 2-285 Thornleigh (with 12 members), again 4-581 Boonah (with 13 members), again club 5-725 Port Pirie (with 7 members) and 6-773 Glen Forrest (with 9 members).

For the 20-50 range, numbers are down 151 from last year. For the 50-100 range, numbers are down by 172. For the 100-300, numbers are by 67 and finally, for the 1000+ range, there was a decrease of 34 members over last year.

COVID-19 Reduced Hours
