As the commissions are calculated on the As at 31st December we had 12 clubs with masterpoints submitted by clubs, and this was drastically down this year, there was a double whammy, in that the commissions were reduced from a rate of 20% to 10% halfway through the year.

For those who do not know about the commissions, they are a payment made to your state/territory association each quarter by the Centre. The payment is based on all the red and green masterpoints clubs in your respective state/territory have submitted to the Centre for the quarter.

receives from each state/territory for these submitted awards are refunded to the respective state/territory bodies.

The other various office expenses, printing, stationery, postage, telephone and internet were all down as well, especially as we are only doing quarterly mailouts during the pandemic, as well as a reduction in the Manager fees as the office was only manned for 50% of the time over a 6 week period mid year.

Compared with last year, the Centre saw a drop in total revenue of -\$210,943 or -24.5%.

MONEY MATTERS

As part of the March 2020 update, we issued 333 clubs with invoices for the annual capitation fees for their home club members.

Now at the end of the calendar year I am happy to note that 330 of these clubs, or -28.3 99.1%, have paid their annual capitation fees for their members. This leaves only 3 clubs—1 NSW, 1 VIC & 1 SA—still to pay their capitation fees.

> overdue accounts, which would obviously include the 3 clubs mentioned above. There are 3 NSW, 6 VIC, 2 SA & 1 NT clubs with an overdue account.

During the pandemic the Centre has attempted to assist clubs by refunding any excess payments they have made to the Centre. We managed to get this figure down from 9 clubs to just 2. Unfortunately this has blown out to 7 clubs again just prior to the December update. Once the December invoices were included 5 of these credit amounts were swallowed up by the Q4/20 invoices issued Currently 10% of the revenue the Centre at the end of December, leaving just 2 clubs in credit, again!!
